CCAFS helps establish a framework for Myanmar's policies, programs and investments on climate-smart agriculture

In 2015, the Ministry of Agriculture, Livestock, and Irrigation (MOALI), together with CCAFS, developed the Myanmar Climate-Smart Agricultural Strategy (MCSAS) to guide the implementation of climate actions in Myanmar. **To date, MCSAS has been referenced in at least 19 government and NGO programs, 4 policy documents, and 19 investment projects, with an approximate worth of USD 1 billion.**

Furthermore, other CSA technologies and approaches were mainstreamed by various stakeholders as recommended in the MCSAS, such as the Climate-Smart Village (CSV) and climate-smart rice production.
