Description of activity / study: A new part of the second phase of A4NH had an intentional focus on nutrition leadership, which built on evidence and experience from key partners like the African Nutrition Leadership Program, the Institute of Development Studies, and A4NH's own bilateral projects. Due to limited resources and capacity, the scope of the study changed. Rather than an evaluation, A4NH developed a theory of change to reflect on how it supported nutrition leadership development. Using program documents, peer-reviewed and grey literature, and interviews, a short internal report describes an initial theory of change. It could be used by CGIAR, or its partners, as a starting point for future evaluations and/or to refine future data collection, analysis, or reporting of nutrition leadership development activities.
