Description of activity / study: Because of COVID pandemic, CBD/COP was postponed (again) until 2022, giving CCAFS more time/opportunities to influence the Post 2020 Global Biodiversity Framework (Post2020GBF) negotiations. In 2021, CCAFS continued promoting inclusion, in Post2020GBF, of: a) Plant Treaty's multilateral system of access and benefit-sharing (MLS) and increased availability/transfers of PGRFA, b) related indicators for non-monetary benefit sharing. Actions included 1. submitting on-line comments to revised drafts released by Secretariat, and 2. making CGIAR report & oral interventions to UNFAO's Commission on Genetic Resources for Food and Agriculture (CGRFA), September 2021, and rallying support from contracting parties/regions, for the two following resolutions adopted by all 184 member countries: a resolution to send from CGRFA to CBD/COP urging inclusion of the Plant Treaty's MLS in the Post2020GBF; and a resolution directing the Secretariats of CGRFA, CBD, Plant Treaty to work together on a study of options for monitoring non-monetary benefit-sharing, including potentially, under Post2020GBF.
