SRF 2022/2030 targets:

- # of more people, of which 50% are women, meeting minimum dietary energy requirements

Description of activity / study: This is a randomized control trial in the Upper East region of Ghana where randomly selected groups of farmers got guaranteed credit access to buy motor pumps. It is a multi-year project involving baseline data collection, undertaking the intervention, waiting for a couple of years to provide the intervention the chance to influence nutrition and gender outcomes, doing an end line survey and analysis. We plan to finalize the project in 2019.
