

Addendum No: 001
To
Memorandum of Understanding

This document forms a part of the Memorandum of Understanding of 1st March 1991, signed, for the provision of the building at No 127, Sunil Mawatha, Pelawatta, Thalangama South, Sri Jayawardenapura, and is to be read in conjunction with the said Memorandum of Understanding.

Whereas

1. The Government of Sri Lanka has acquired the above building from Ceylon Petroleum Corporation (C.P.C) and compensates C.P.C., on the valuation of the Chief Government Valuer, a sum of Rupees Seventy two Millions Five hundred thousand (Rs. 72,500,000/=).
2. Part of the above amounting to Rupees Fifty four Millions Three hundred and seventy five thousands (Rs. 54,375,000/=) is provided by the donors of Major Irrigation Rehabilitation Project and the balance sum of Rupees Eighteen Millions One hundred and twenty five thousand (Rs. 18,125,000) by the Government of Sri Lanka.
3. International Irrigation management Institute has agreed to assist the government of Sri Lanka by providing a part of the contribution by government of Sri Lanka, amounting to Rupees Ten Millions (Rs. 10,000,000/=).


NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AS FOLLOWS:-

1. I.I.M.I. will provide to government of Sri Lanka a sum of Rupees Ten Millions (Rs. 10,000,000/=).
2. I.I.M.I. will use the building for a period of 25 years as described in Memorandum of Understanding
3. In the event the government of Sri Lanka calls upon I.I.M.I. to hand back the building, the government of Sri Lanka will compensate I.I.M.I., for the contribution by I.I.M.I. to the acquisition of the said building, as follows:-

Compensation (Rupees) = $10,000,000 \times (300 - \text{Number of Months occupied by I.I.M.I.}) / 300$


