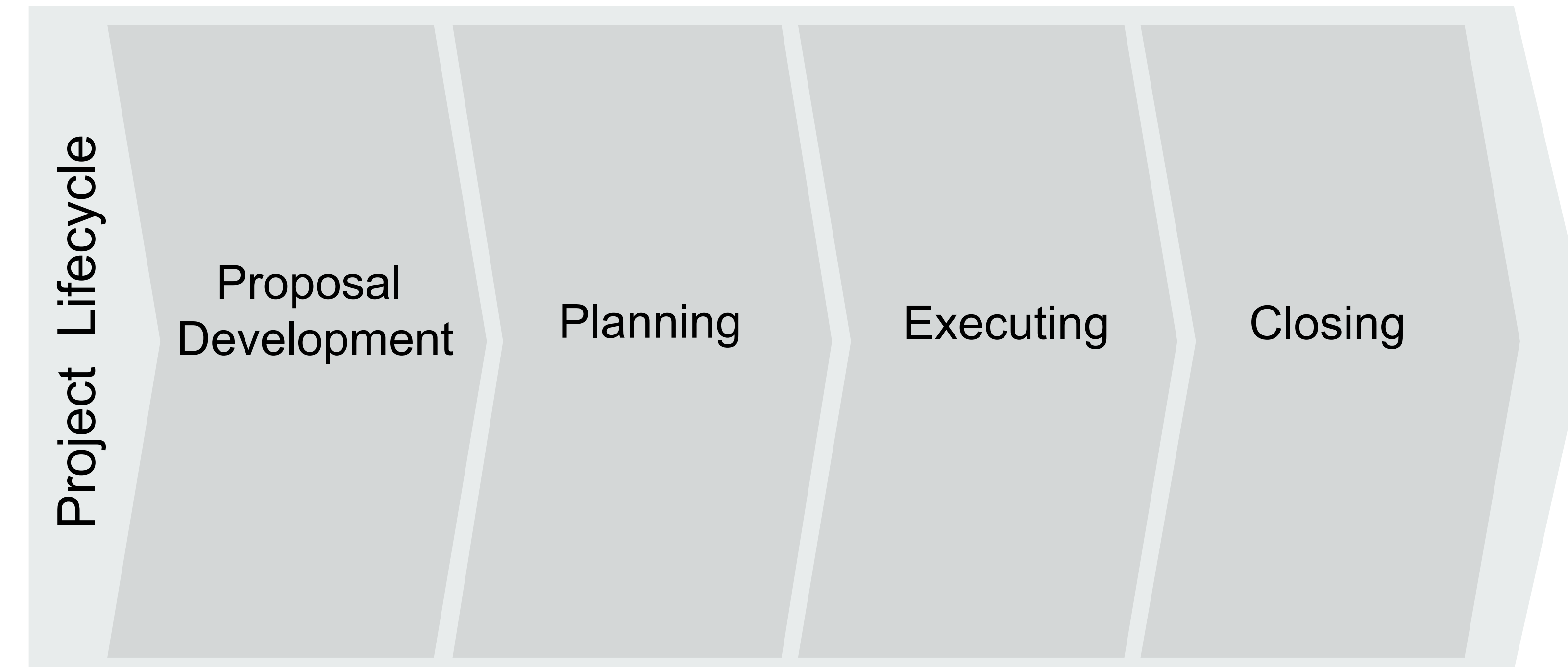


Strategy and programming process

- The Program Management Framework provides a framework for Program Leaders, Principal Investigators, Project Leads, Program Management Officers, project team members, and other project stakeholders to guide project and program delivery
- It helps increase efficiency and delivery
- It defines roles involved and identifies accountability for each step and activity.
- It focuses on four key project phases:

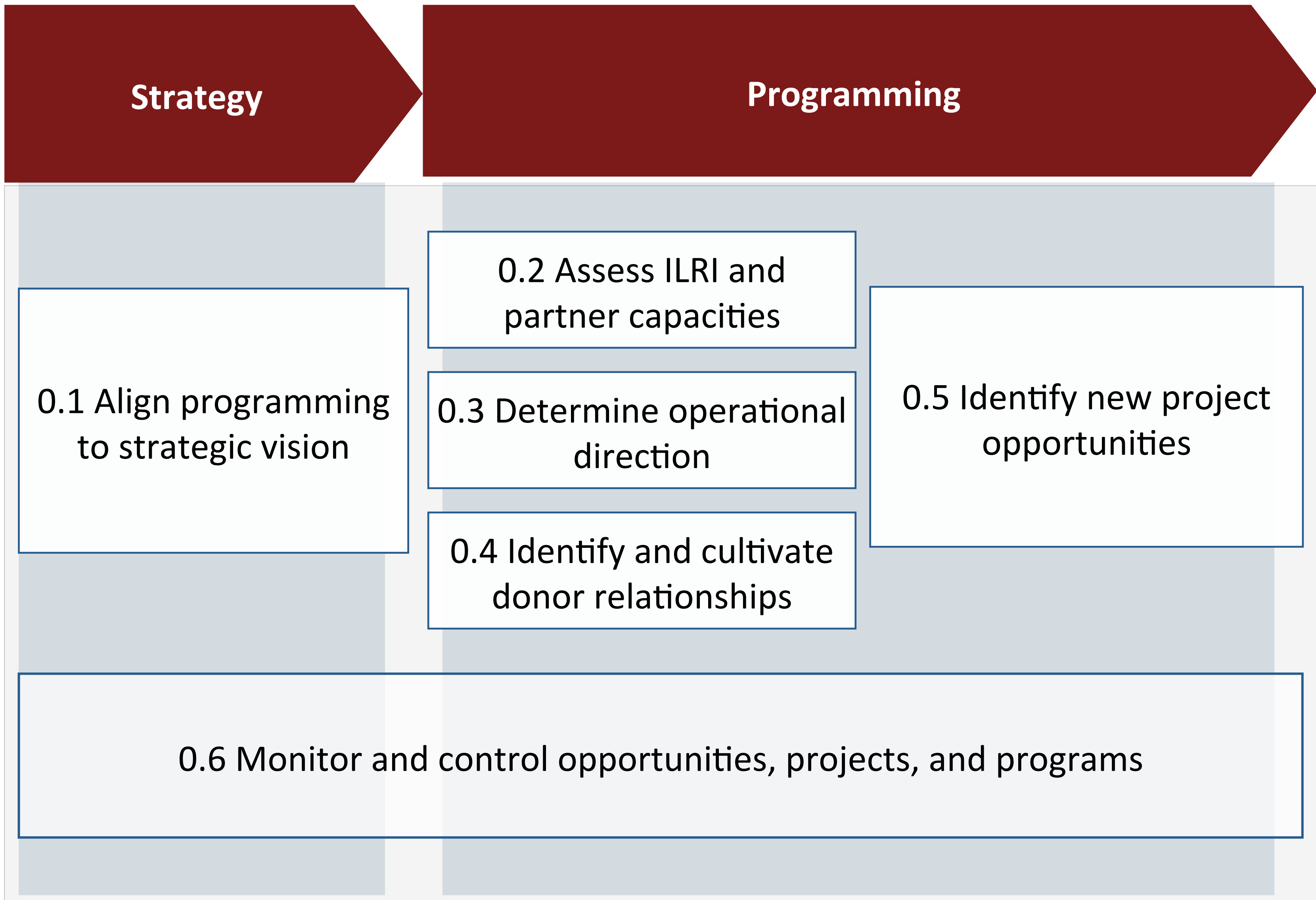

Objectives:

- Provides a standard approach for staff to follow when managing programs and projects
- Ensures that the necessary program/project management activities are being performed throughout the organization, increasing delivery outcomes and the ability to meet donor expectations
- Offers clarity regarding who is responsible for completing activities and which tools are to be used
- Enables future growth in this area using the defined processes as the baseline for what program/project management is at ILRI

- The Program Management Framework should be utilized on projects where ILRI is the lead implementer or owns a significant portion of implementation responsibility
- It can be utilized to provide structure in project execution for any initiative in which ILRI is engaged in project execution activities
