

Tipper Trailer

The tipper trailer is used for transporting field produce, firewood, construction materials and various goods. It is pulled by a two-wheel tractor and has deck covered sides for the safety of goods. The trailer is a source of great income through hire and significantly reduces physical labor.

Key Advantages

Set Up and Operation

- Check two-wheel tractor oil, fuel, and water levels
- Check the tyre pressure, tighten the trailer bolts and nuts including the wheel nuts
- Hitch the trailer to the two-wheel tractor
- Engage the trailer foot brake to aid in the braking process
- Stop the tractor and unhitch the trailer
- Clean and store under a shade

Safety Measures

- The trailer must be operated by a trained operator only (adult). Do not operate it under the influence of alcohol
- All loading and unloading should be done when the trailer is stationary
- Always operate the trailer at safe speed for easy control
- All safety chains, and mechanisms including the trailer foot brake should always be in working order
- Use low gear, while driving uphill or downhill.
