

Hub Replication

- Farmer sustainability: Increased milk production; increased yield per cow; decreasedseasonality, increased farmer income and establish dairy as a profession of choice for youth.
- Dairy Hub sustainability: Increased value proposition to members and markets; proactive leadership &management and making hubs becoming independent and sustainable.
- Gender equity: Increased women active suppliers; and increased women decision making at households and hubs.
- Hub model replication: Hub approach adoption by other stakeholders through evidence based learning and industry sub-sector coordination.
