



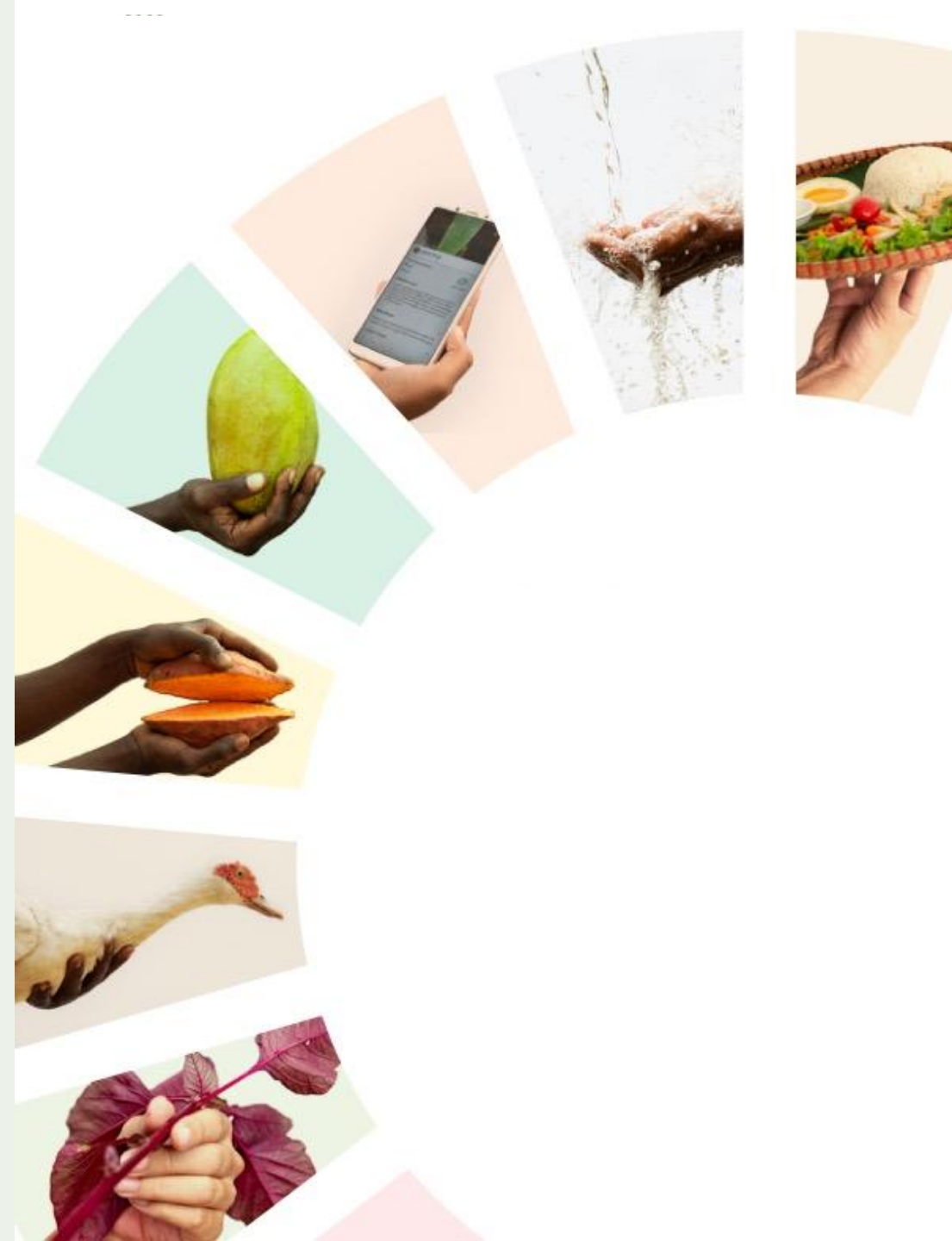

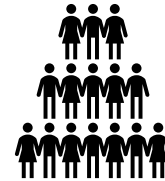
COP28 was a landmark moment for CGIAR with \$890M in pledges

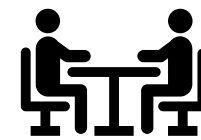
Investment Case sent to **11,000+** stakeholders

200+ events with RBAs and partners



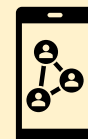

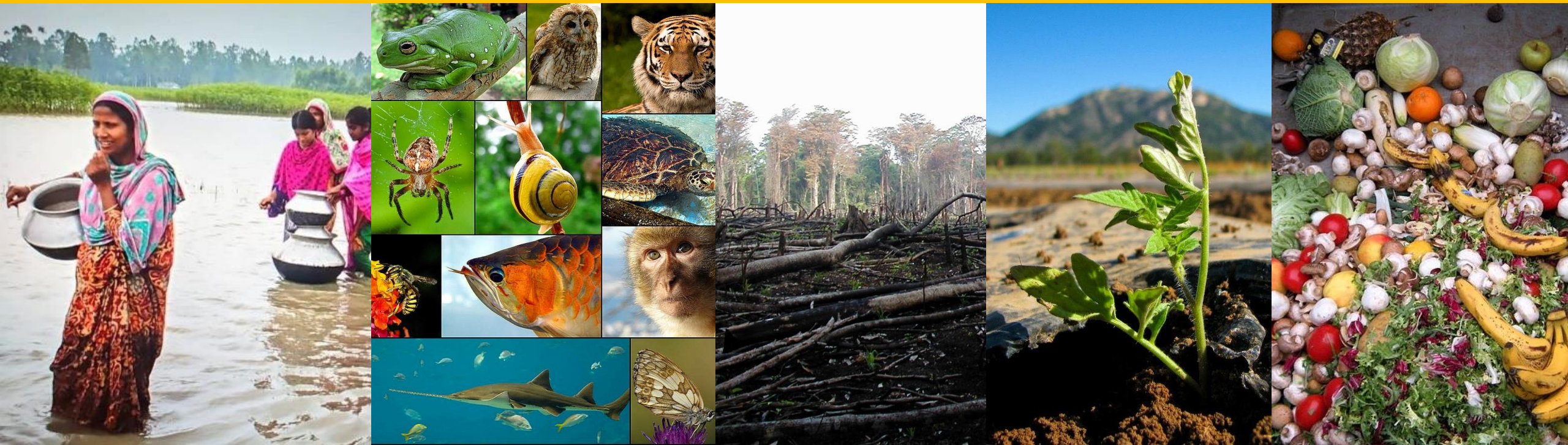

threaten **86%** of species currently at risk of extinction

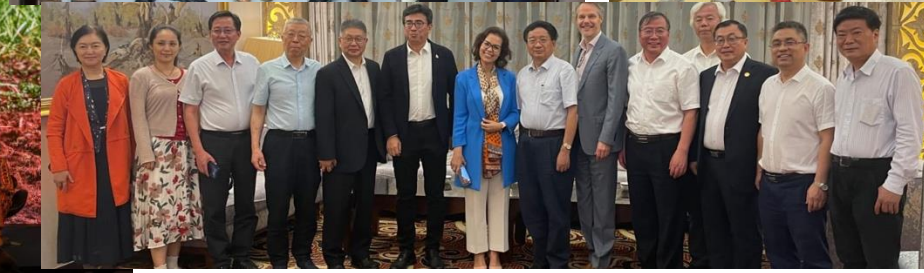

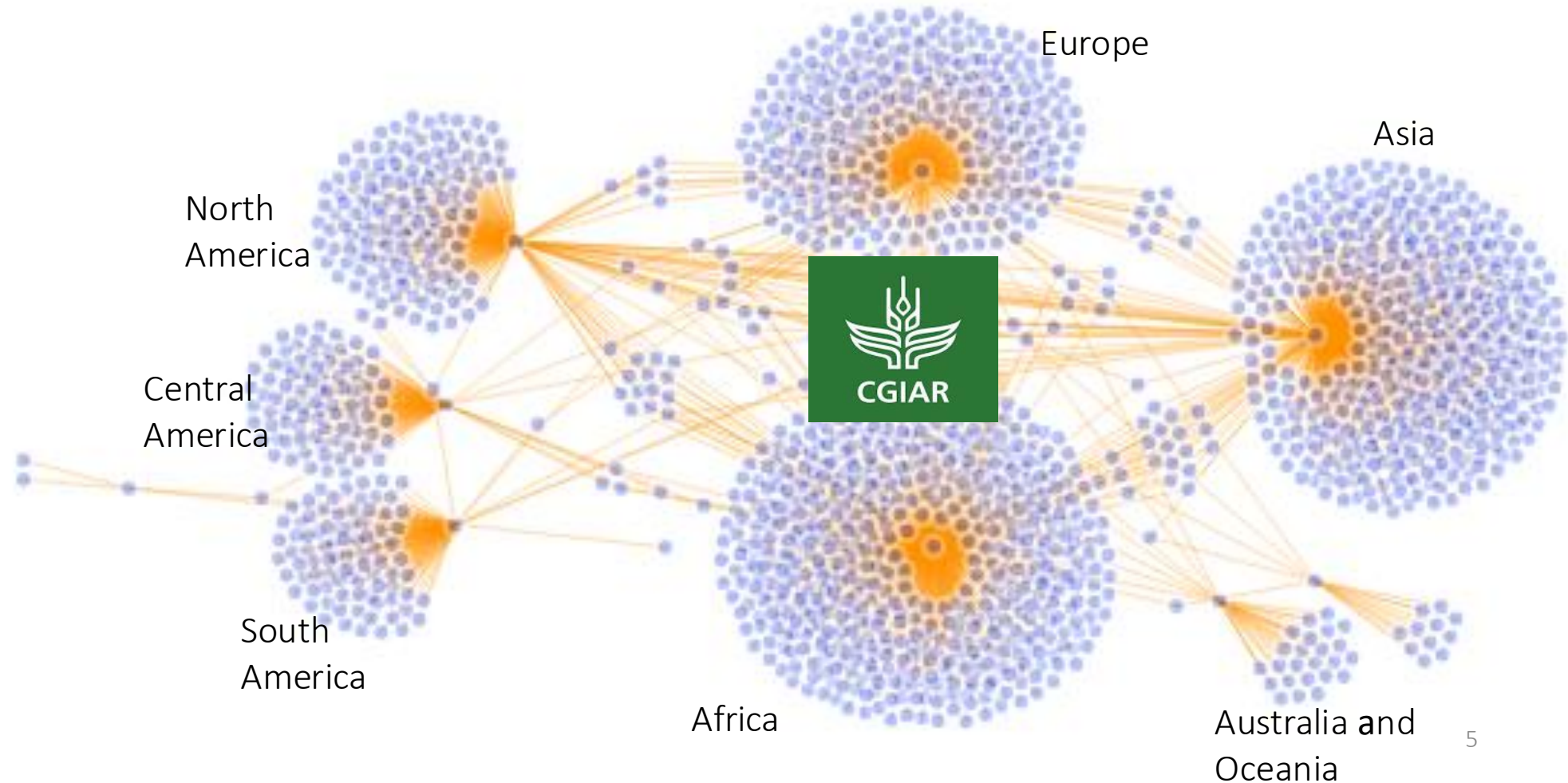

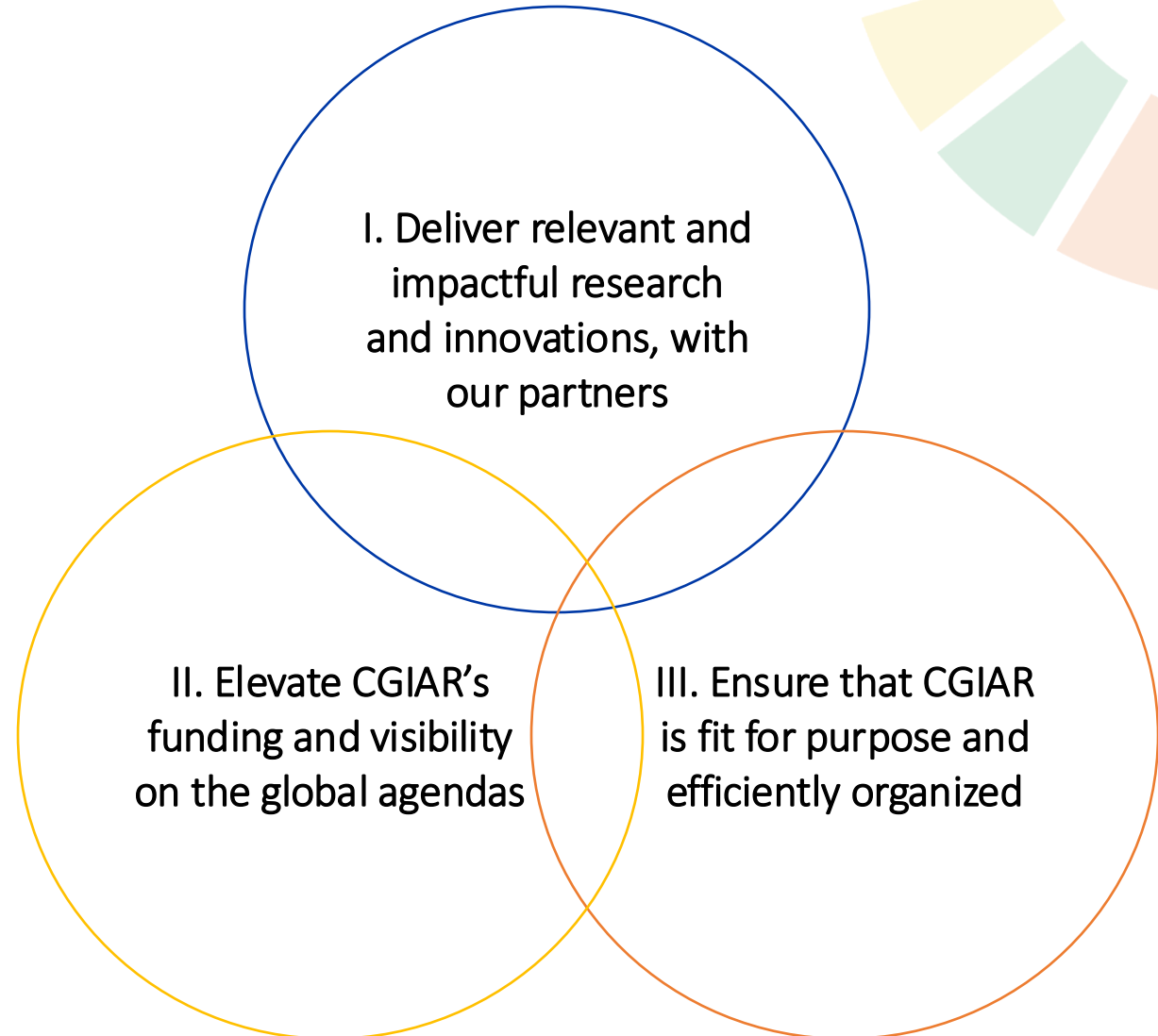
CGIAR's leadership's strategic priorities are to move from reform to an operating business model

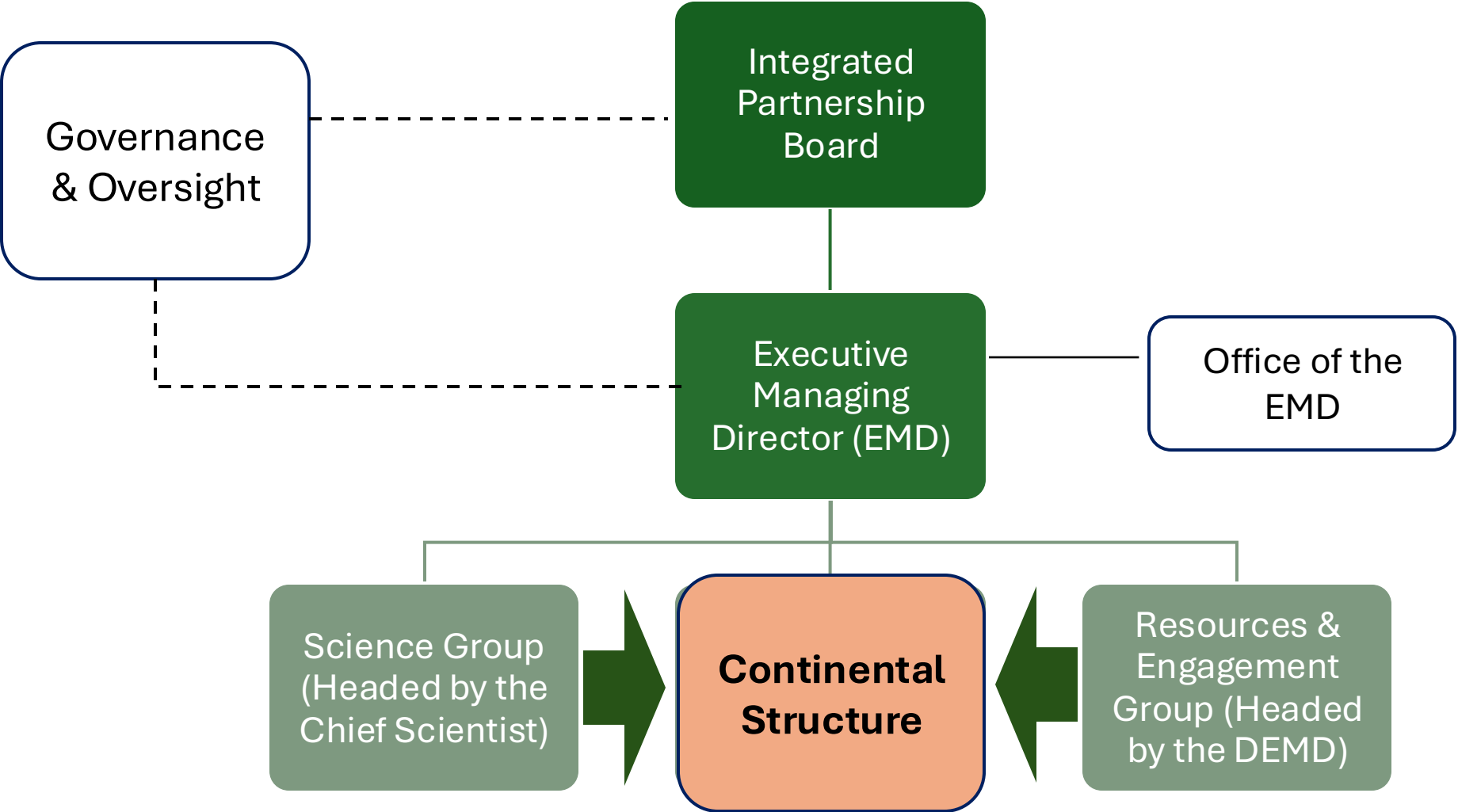
Science Portfolio is being setup to be an annual \$2B portfolio
