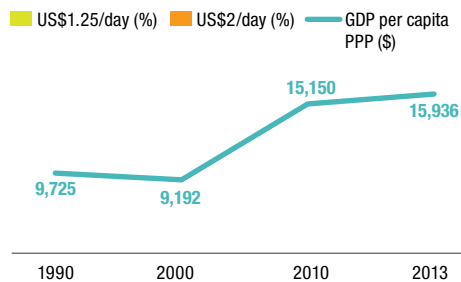


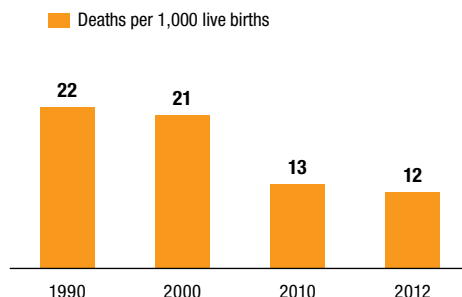

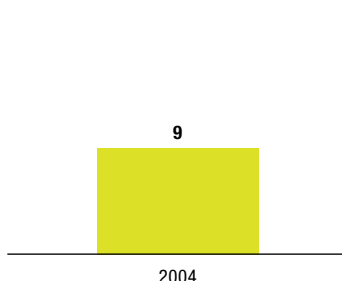

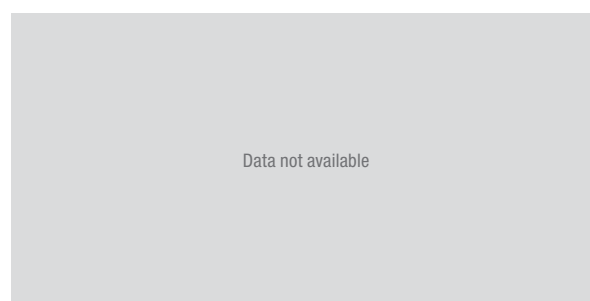

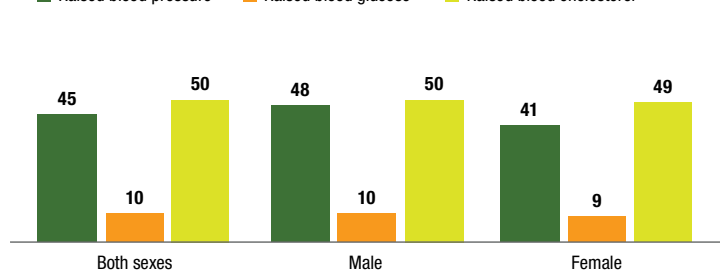

■ Raised blood pressure ■ Raised blood glucose ■ Raised blood cholesterol



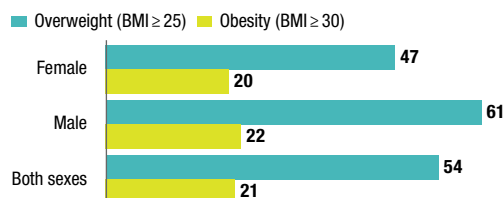

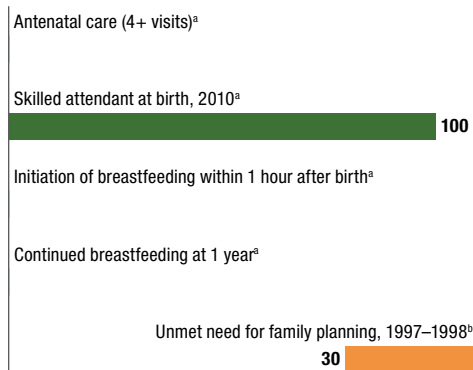

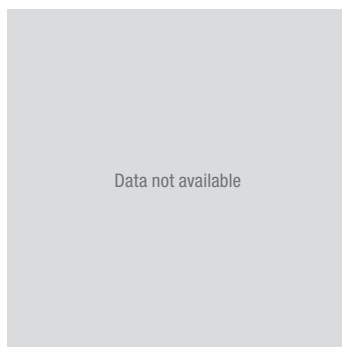
INTERVENTION COVERAGE AND CHILD-FEEDING PRACTICES

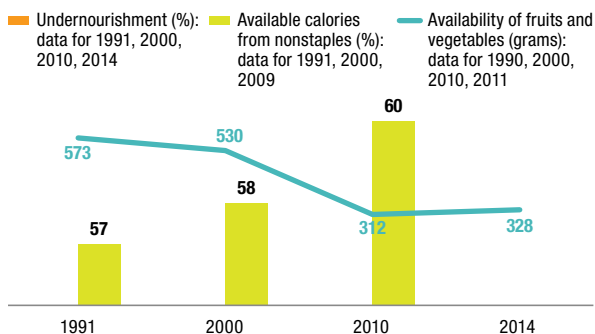

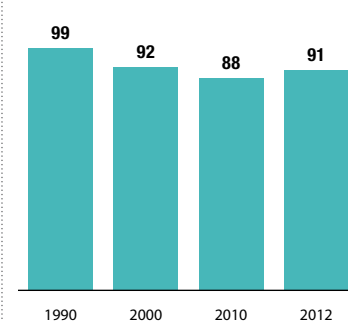

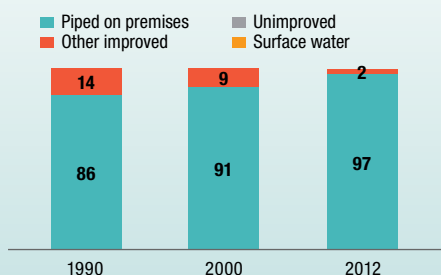

FEMALE SECONDARY EDUCATION ENROLLMENT (%)



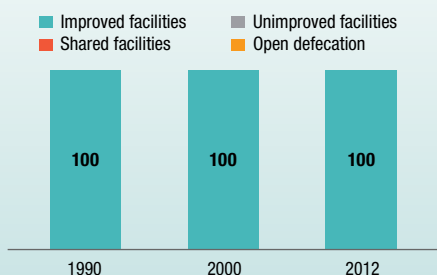

IMPROVED DRINKING WATER COVERAGE (%)



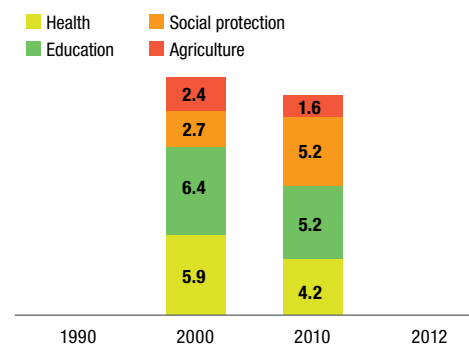

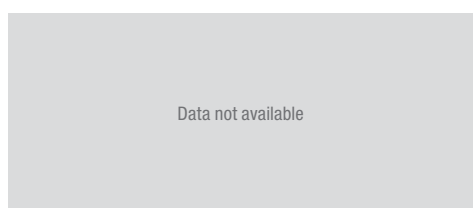
GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURES (%)
