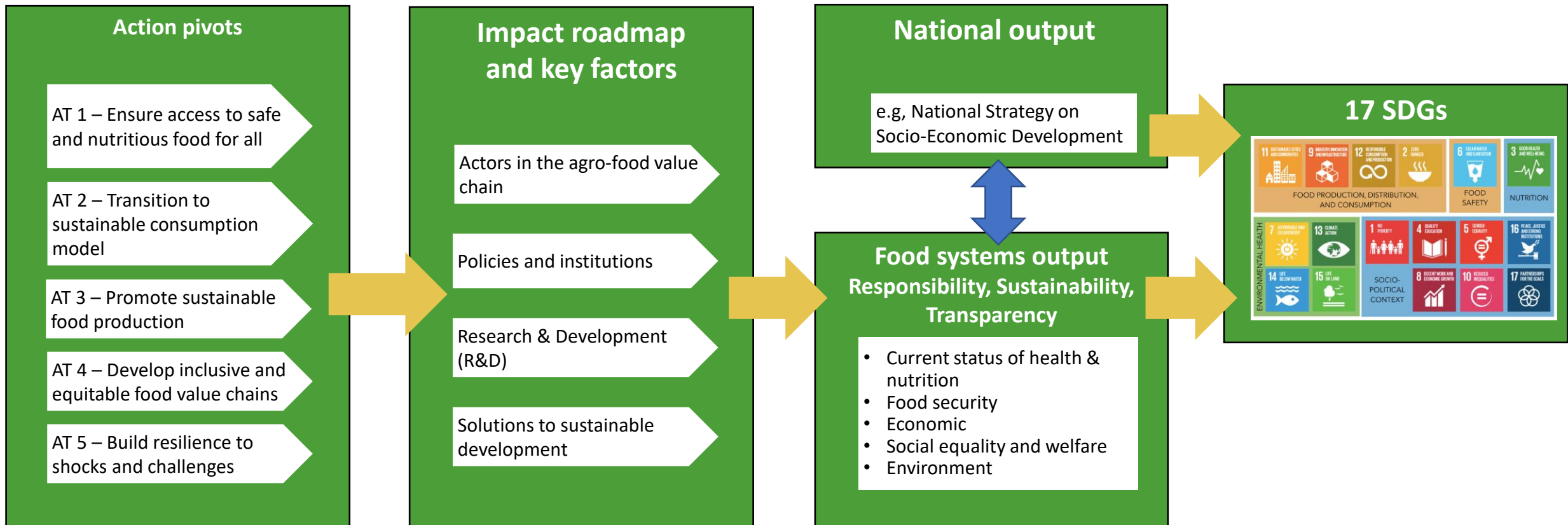

Overall goals of the Food Systems Action Plan

The National Action Plan on Food System to 2030 aims to orient and coordinate strategies, plans and activities of domestic and foreign organizations to develop a responsible, transparent and sustainable food system of Vietnam by 2030, which serves as a basis for the implementation of the 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development

Specific objectives of the Action Plan

1. Ensure access to safe and nutritious food for all
2. Transition to sustainable food consumption and use
3. Promote sustainable, responsible, green and low GHG agricultural production
4. Develop competitive, transparent, inclusive and fair food value chains
5. Enhance people's resilience to vulnerabilities, shocks and stress
6. Strengthen inter-sectoral linkage and coordination among government ministries, international organizations and private sector in implementing National Target programs (Sustainable poverty reduction, New rural construction and Socio-economic development for ethnic minorities and mountainous areas); Agricultural Strategy, Agricultural Restructuring Plan, Zero Hunger Program, National Strategy on Nutrition, NDC-Paris Agreement and SENDAI framework.

Specific objective 1: Ensure access to safe and nutritious food for all

Content 1.1. Improve the food system using a multi-sectoral approach, increase food production and access to diverse, healthy food at reasonable prices for the people.

Content 1.2. Improve food safety systems through capacity building, increased risk-based management and information transparency

Specific objective 2: Transition to sustainable consumption model

Content 2.1. Reduce food loss and waste

Content 2.2. Change in food consumption behavior and use based on output in improving nutritional status

Content 2.3. Dissemination of the One Health Initiative

Specific objective 3: Promote sustainable, responsible, green and low GHG agriculture production

Content 3.1. Transition to ecological agricultural production (agroforestry, organic, IPM, SRI/SRP, VAC, landscape agriculture, favorable weather...)

Content 3.2. Sustainable livestock development

Content 3.3. Sustainable aquaculture development

Content 3.4. Sustainable forestry development

Content 3.5. Improve irrigation system, save water

Specific objective 4: Develop competitive, transparent, inclusive and fair food value chains

Content 4.1. Enhance digital transformation to increase transparency of the food value chain

Content 4.2. Policies that encourage private sector investment in the logistics infrastructure of the food system (distribution systems, cold chains, transportation) and financial policies that enhance the safety and competitiveness of food value chain

Content 4.3. Promote advanced technology research and application in the preservation and processing of agricultural products to increase the proportion of deeply processed foods and develop the circular economy in the food value chain.

Content 4.4. Build and disseminate diversified value chain linkage models

Content 4.5. Strengthen solutions to support the expansion of the international agricultural food market

Specific objective 5: Strengthen the resilience of people and the Food System to vulnerabilities, shocks and stress

Content 5.1. Invest in large-scale training and technical assistance to assist vulnerable farmers, cooperatives, and businesses in adopting good agricultural practices and increasing resilience

Content 5.2. Policies and regulations that allow farmers to more easily diversify crops and make food systems more sustainable

Content 5.3. Basic business management support and risk reduction planning training, and application of digital tools to strengthen the financial resilience of vulnerable cooperatives and businesses

Content 5.4. Accelerate research and development of improved breeds that are better adapted to climate change and natural disasters

Content 5.5. Conserve and exploit indigenous plant and animal breeds for sustainable development of the Food system
